

Cleaning Instructions for Marching Uniforms
and Blue Performance Tops:

1. Remove the red cape from the jacket by unsnapping it. The cape will be dry cleaned at a later date.
2. Wash the jacket, top and bibbers (pants) all separately.
3. Use only non chlorine detergent. PERSIL stain fighter is good but you can use any non-chlorine detergent. **Do not use** bleach or fabric softener on any part of the uniform.
4. Wash in Cold Water Only
5. Jacket: turn it inside out & wash in cold water on the gentle cycle. Hang to dry.
6. Sequined Top: Hand wash inside out in cold water. Lay flat to dry.
7. Bibbers: Wash in cold water on the gentle cycle. Lay flat to dry.
8. Performance tops (Blue jockey tops): Remove the safety pins connecting the bow tie. Place the top back in the mesh bag. Wash in cold water on the gentle cycle. Lay flat to dry it. Once dry, please replace the bow tie using the middle pin and two safety pins on the sides. Place back in the mesh bag.
9. Do not press any part of the uniform with a hot iron.
10. Hang the uniform on one hanger and place it back in the garment bag.
