Changes to bylaws presented by Mrs. Triggs.

- 1. Article II Definitions Called Meeting (remove "Band parents" and replace with the membership). "A special meeting of the membership called by the Board of Directors, scheduled at least one week in advance and not in conflict with the school calendar. Notice of the meeting must be sent to the membership..."
- 2. Article II Quorum: ...five members of the Board of Directors are required to conduct the business of the Board **of Directors.**
- 3. Article II Regularly Scheduled Meetings: we need to add online or electronic meetings to this.
- 4. Article V Board of Directors (Officers) Treasurers (should be plural).
- 5. Article V Removal from Office 1. Any Board of Director member who is absent...(rather than saying Executive Board). Unless we are changing the name of the Board throughout the document.

- 6. Article V Duties: "authority" should not be capitalized.
- 7. Article V Vice President of Chaperones (plural) and #8 "crew members" is two words.
- 8. Article 5 remove #4 and 5 from Vice President of Equipment and put those items under Vice President of Logistics as #6 and 7.
- 9. Article X Standing Committees #6 Spirit change "paraphernalia" to merchandise
- 10. Article X Standing Committees #7.3 change wording to "send corporate and student fundraising opportunities to alumni".
- 11. Article X Standing Committees #11 "Hydration" can be removed. We do not have this committee now that students carry their own band water jugs.

Motion was made and was supported to move forward with voting on proposed changes.

Mrs. Triggs provided additional proposed changes:

- I. Pre-authorization needed from the president of the plan to spend more than \$250, would like to extend this requirement to all board members.
- II. Spouse BPA positions. Spouses can serve in different BPA positions; just not serve as the leads of two different positions.
- Iii. If there's a position open and no one has volunteered for it, the previous position holder can hold position again even if it's a 3rd year.

Motion was made and supported to add proposed changes from Mrs. Triggs to the upcoming voting on amendments to the bylaws.
